- have the freedom to speak their own language
- practice their own religion
- live their own culture

e) What does "autonomy" mean to China?

- destroyed most monasteries
- made Chinese the first language
- have hundreds of thousands of settlers move in

- years from now there are more Chinese in Tibet than Tibetans → no real Tibet, only tourist attraction
